Intergenerational Camp (All are welcome)

Intergenerational Camp is a new camp for 2026. It is an opportunity to experience camp with all ages, for families and friends to experience the wonders of camp side by side. Intergenerational camp will continue to build a foundational love of camp for all ages!

You & Me (ages 5-8 and an adult)

You & Me Camps are designed for children who are 5-8 years old, plus an adult. The adult can be a grandparent, parent, or other trusted adult and may accompany more than one child to camp and need not be a biological relative. This **3-day** a unique opportunity for young children to have a introduction to camp in a safe and comfortable environment **Both adult and camper MUST register.**

New Beginnings (completed grades 1-3)

New Beginnings is more than just an introduction to camp. It is **3 days** of fun, study, worship, singing and relationship building. Campers learn the traditions of camp and begin to create some of their own. Along with caring counselors, campers experience the unique flavor of a week of church camp in just 48 hours. Come, join the fun!

Explorer (completed grades 4-5)

At Explorer Camp, fourth and fifth graders experience a **full week** of fun, learning, worship and singing with the new friends they will meet! Campers will discover much about themselves through the traditions of camp as they begin to explore their relationship with Christ.

Middle School (completed grades 6-8)

At Middle School Camp, campers have an opportunity to ask serious questions about life and about their relationship with God! They will use scripture to talk about things important to you, while learning more about living out faith.

High School (completed grades 9-12)

High School Camp is a week full of fun, learning, and leadership. Using scripture as a guide, youth gather to build a Christian community of lasting friendships, where together they learn about themselves, and how to live out their faith.

M.A.D. (Music, Art, Drama) (completed grades 6-12)

M.A.D. Camp appeals to youth with talents or interests in the arts. This camp explores creative ways of using the arts in worship and living a life of faith. This camp encourages youth to explore and hone their talents while learning and have fun. Camp culminates in a production for campers' families to attend.

C.R.O.S.S. (Christian Recreation and Outdoor Sports Skills) (completed grades 6-12)
